

Support for Congress acting immediately to pass legislation to provide the FDA broader authority to recall food when it poses a danger to health and safety is very strong at 80%. Few (16%) oppose.

Support is strong across all demographic groups and regions.

Method

Telephone surveys utilizing a random probability sample of telephone households were conducted among 1,007 adults.

Interviewing took place from June 24 – June 27, 2010.

The questionnaire was fielded via Opinion Research Corporation's Caravan twice-weekly national telephone omnibus survey.

ORC used a probability sample of telephone households to achieve a nationally representative probability sample and weighted completed interviews by age, sex, geographic region and race.

The margin of error is 3.2% at the 95% level of confidence.
